

Product Stewardship	EPR
Allocate responsibility to provincial/territorial or municipal governments	Allocate responsibility to producers
Consumer fees or government fund program	Producers fund program



#### **OBLIGATIONS**

How is the obligated steward/producer determined?




**Some programs/jurisdictions** – obligations are determined by a clear hierarchy based on "residency"



In other cases, determination of obligated entity is less defined, more than one entity may meet the criteria




#### **KEY TAKEAWAYS**
